



Multi-Family Project Experience

Veer Architecture PLLC has a broad portfolio of multi-family project experience ranging from urban infill type buildings located in the City of Seattle, the City of Tacoma and the downtown areas of Bellevue, Kirkland, Mercer Island and Renton to more suburban type projects located in outlying areas where there are multiple buildings set in a garden style or townhouse arrangement.

Notable completed recent projects include 95 Burnett, a 110 unit six level apartment project in downtown Renton comprised of both a tower of flats and townhouse style units that relate to the street. Supporting functions include associated tenant common areas including a large outdoor plaza, a party room and workout facility. Another recently completed project is Harrington Square in the Renton Highlands area. This project includes street level commercial space and 4 levels of apartment units. On the other end of the scale is the Georgetown Lofts project located as the name suggests in the Georgetown neighborhood of Seattle. This project is a model for dense urban townhouse development. The units in this project are characterized by an open industrial style aesthetic which relates to much of the original architectural make up of this community.
